**2015 Adopt-A-Spot Fact Sheet**

**Benefits of the Adopt-A-Spot Programs**

- ❖ Provide businesses, neighborhood groups, civic organizations, and individuals an ongoing opportunity to participate in creating a cleaner, more beautiful community
- ❖ Allow for greater community involvement in greening and maintaining the Town's neighborhoods, streets, conservation land and parks
- ❖ All participating groups will be recognized in local newspapers, on the Town web site and in the Town Report of their participation in the Program

**General Adopt-A Spot Information**

- ❖ Spots in this Program available for adoption are designated "gardening spots", "clean up spots", or "Fee-For-Service spots"
  - "Clean up spots" are recreation property, conservation areas, and along Town roadways where the group must clean up litter and other debris at least four times during the Program
  - "Gardening spots" are smaller areas near municipal buildings, in Town parks, or around other focal points in the community where the group must plant and maintain regularly a flower garden throughout the four month Program
  - "Fee for Service spots" are high traffic areas along Route 111 that are professionally maintained and landscaped and the adoptee helps for pay for the maintenance and additional landscaping
- ❖ Each Spot will be adopted for a 4 month (June-September) duration
- ❖ Clean up of Spots will be coordinated with the Community Development Department, litter and debris will be collected in Town provided bags, and will be brought to the Transfer Station for disposal
- ❖ Groups will provide the Community Development Department with periodic updates as to work done at each adopted spot
- ❖ Groups participating in the Program will receive the following:
  - Safety material (and sign waiver attesting that they received said information)
  - Safety vests to be worn and signs to be placed when working on or near a roadway
  - Landscaping materials, such as mulch and plants, to be used at the adopted spot
