Campbell Farm Sub-Committee Site Visit

- The sub-committee had a walk-through of the Campbell Farm house, fields and alternate access area. General opinion is that although the integrity of the structure has been maintained, the building needs updating. A community meeting has been proposed to hear ideas from the general public for the property.

Moekel Pond and Campbell Farm By-laws

- Discussion to keep by-laws in accordance with what is currently maintained for all town conservation lands – such as no ATVs, no firearms hunting – with no specific changes mentioned.
 - Moekel Pond by-laws should be tied in with Deer Leap by-laws.
 - Campbell Farm will likely be utilized as a winter resource for activities such as cross-country skiing as no trails exist.
