

Please join us to learn more about the Merrimack Valley Reliability Project, a proposed electric transmission system upgrade between Londonderry, NH, and Tewksbury, MA. The new overhead electric transmission line will be approximately 24.5 miles in length and constructed by National Grid and Eversource. Approximately 18 miles of the line will run in New Hampshire, passing through Londonderry, Hudson, Windham, and Pelham along existing utility rights-of-way.

As part of the state siting process, the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee is hosting Public Information Sessions in both Rockingham and Hillsborough Counties. See the reverse side for details.



Merrimack Valley Reliability Project

The Merrimack Valley Reliability Project's proposed electric transmission improvements will strengthen the electric system to better serve residents and businesses in southern New Hampshire and northeastern Massachusetts. As part of the approval process, Eversource and National Grid have filed an application for a Certificate of Site and Facility from the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (SEC) in order to construct and operate the proposed transmission line.
