HIGHWAY SAFETY MEETING

- APRIL 10, 2006

On April 10, 2006, the Department Heads discussed the following requests for highway safety improvements and made the following recommendations.

**Attendance:** David Sullivan, Al Turner, Tom McPherson, Gerry Lewis, Al Barlow, Rex Norman and Jack McCartney were in attendance. Meeting began at 10:20 am on site at Griffin Park.

### HIGHWAY SAFETY ISSUES:

#### **Parking Area at 112 Range Road (across from Griffin Park) –**

The Committee reviewed plans to construct a parking area of approximately 100 spaces on the site across from Griffin Park (112 Range Road), along with relocating the center driveway of Griffin Park to align with the proposed driveway into the new parking area, and construction of a pedestrian crosswalk to connect the two areas.

The land at 112 Range Road is currently owed by Mr. Mesiti, who has offered to donate the land as well as the construction services required to build the proposed parking area.

The Committee reviewed the site distances along Range Road and Horseshoe Road as well as a speed survey conducted by the Police Department for this area. The survey indicted an 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed of 38 mph. Mr. Lewis moved to have the Highway Safety Committee endorse the project as proposed with the following additions:

- Installation of three (3) street lights on the Griffin Park side of Range Road to be located on the poles closest to the center driveway and crosswalk as well as near the remaining two entrances to the Park.
- Installation of “No Bus Parking” and “Bus Drop-Off Only” signs in the current Griffin Park parking area.
- Recommend to the State that they install “No Parking” signs on the West Side of Range Road in the area of Griffin Park. Distance of “No Parking” area to be determined between the Town and State.

Mr. Barlow seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. McPherson moved to adjourn. Mr. Lewis seconded. Passed unanimously.  
Meeting adjourned at 11:15 pm
