HIGHWAY SAFETY MEETING

- DECEMBER 1, 2006

On December 1, 2006, the Department Heads discussed the following requests for highway safety improvements and made the following recommendations.

PLANNING BOARD PLANS:

Johnny Hill Subdivision

The Committee reviewed the plans submitted for the above reference subdivision. The Committee found no issues with the plans as submitted however did recommend that the applicant contribute towards improvements to London Bridge Road.

HIGHWAY SAFETY ISSUES:

Osgood and Marblehead Road Intersection

- The following request was received:
 - Correct the "line of sight" on Marblehead Road near its intersection with Osgood Street.

The concern expressed was that when proceeding on Marblehead Road in an easterly direction (heading towards Fletchers Corner) there is insufficient line of sight to oncoming traffic for cars turning onto Osgood Street.

The Committee recessed the meeting to travel to the location of concern. Upon review of the area, the Committee felt that the current line of sight looking in both directions from Osgood Street was satisfactory, however all present agreed to look into cutting back the slope directly across from Osgood Street to provide addition line of sight. The Committee agreed to research the property line boundaries and determine whether improvements can be made within town bounds or involved permission from abutters. Once boundary ownership is confirmed the Committee will work with the Highway Agent to effectuate some improvement.

Mr. Barlow moved to adjourn. Mr. Lewis seconded. Passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 4:05 pm.

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
