On June 3, 2009, the department heads discussed the following highway safety improvements and made the following recommendations.

Attendance: Laura Scott, Tom McPherson, Bob Leuci, Al Barlow and Bob Coole were present. Absent were Gerald Lewis and Jack McCartney. Meeting called began at 0900 hrs at Windham Fire Department.

MINUTES

Members reviewed minutes of May 6, 2009. Motion to approve made by Laura Scott. Bob Leuci seconded and passed unanimously;

PLANNING BOARD PLANS

GOLDEN BROOK SCHOOL MODULAR BUILDING –

Tom McPherson reviewed the site plan with the committee of the proposed site location for the modular building to accommodate public kindergarten. Though not present, Gerald Lewis has expressed concerns over its close proximity with Lowell Road and the traffic pattern and flow associated with it. Further, Tom McPherson indicated that the fire department has been working with the school on site distances between existing school and the modular building, fire alarm system and access. Because of State Aid, the NH Fire Marshal's Office is also reviewing the plan. Tom McPherson will have email/letter drafted to Planning Board reflecting stated concerns. Motion made by Al Barlow. Bob Coole seconded and passed 4-0-1 (Laura Scott abstained)

WINDHAM RESTRAUNT #59 RANGE RD –

Laura Scott discussed plans of closing in existing deck area and putting a second adding seating above on deck style roof. The committee had no issues and the fire department would review plans in detail.

RANGE ROAD SIGNAGE UPDATE –

Tom McPherson reviewed status on signage requested by the Highway Safety Committee and approved by the BOS on September 8, 2008. Letter was sent to Department of Transportation. No answer received. Tom McPherson will follow up with State.

HORSESHOE ROAD –

Tom McPherson reviewed request received by Sue Chapman, 26 Horseshoe Rd. Concerned over parking of vehicles on both sides of road when griffin Park parking over flows. Due to existing narrow width, resident is concerned that Fire/EMS vehicles will not be able to pass. Motion made by Tom McPherson to send letter to BOS requesting “No Parking” be installed on both sides of the road from the intersection of Horseshoe Rd. and Range Rd for approximately 150 feet. Motion seconded by Laura Scott, passed unanimously.

#61 MINISTERIAL ROAD –

Tom McPherson reviewed a letter given to him from Dave Sullivan on an earlier request he had received from the resident of #61 Ministerial Rd. requesting “No Outlet” sign be placed along the beginning of the road as they have witnessed at times large trucks which come down the road and have great difficulty turning around. After discussion, the committee felt that due to the lack of complaints that have been received, these are isolated incidents and at this time choose to take no action. The committee will defer the issue to the Police Department.

FISH RD –

Laura Scott briefed the committee on an on-going neighbor dispute at 21 Fish Rd. which dates back to 2003. After lengthy discussion and review of documents and pictures, the issue is deferred to Public Safety Officials. Tom McPherson will be researching any past documentation which may or may not have dealt with this issue.
