

RULES AND REGULATIONS
GOVERNING USE OF WINDHAM TOWN COMMON:

- A) The common may be utilized by the following at no charge:
 - 1. Taxpayers of the Town of Windham
 - 2. Town Organizations
 - 3. Private Organizations
- B) Request for use must be made with the Selectman's Office at least two (2) weeks prior to scheduled event.
- C) There shall be no discharge of firearms for ceremonial or other purposes on the common.
- D) There shall be no fires permitted on the common, with the exception of candles which may be held by individuals participating in ceremonies such as weddings, etc. They may not be placed along or attached to any structure on the common.
- E) Per Town of Windham Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance (#WIN 2:01:05:81) there shall be no possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the common.
- F) No motor vehicle of any sort shall be ridden or driven on any part of the common.
- G) No person shall gather flowers, wild or cultivated, or remove, cut, break, or mark any tree, shrub or plant within the common.
- H) No person shall deface any monument located within the common.
- I) No person shall deface or damage any wooden structure located within the common including, but not limited to, gazebos, benches, bridges or fences.
- J) No person shall litter or dispose of garbage within the common.
- K) Special exceptions to these rules may be granted by the Town Administrator (ie. Christmas bonfire for town organization).
- L) This policy may, from time to time, be amended by a majority vote of the Board of Selectmen at a regularly scheduled Selectmen's meeting.
