Victim's Bill of Rights

Victims of felonious crimes committed by an adult offender are entitled to the following rights under NHRSA 21-M:8-K

The Right

to be treated with fairness and respect for your dignity and privacy throughout the criminal justice process

to be informed about the criminal justice process and how it progresses

to be free from intimidation and to be reasonably protected from the accused throughout the criminal justice process

to be notified of all court proceedings

to attend trial and all other court proceedings the accused has the right to attend

to confer with the prosecution and to be consulted about the disposition of the case, including plea bargaining

to have inconveniences associated with participation in the criminal justice process minimized

to be notified if presence in court is not required

to be informed about available resources, financial assistance, and social services

to restitution, as granted under RSA 651:62-67 or any other applicable state law, or victim's compensation, under RSA 21-M:8-h or any other applicable state law, for your losses

to be provided a secure, but not necessarily separate, waiting area during court proceedings

to be advised of case progress and final disposition

of confidentiality of the victim's address, place of employment, and other personal information

to the prompt return of property when no longer needed as evidence

to have input in the probation presentence report impact statement

to appear and make a written or oral victim impact statement at the sentencing of the defendant

to be notified of an appeal, an explanation of the appeal process, the time, place and result of the appeal, and the right to attend the appeal hearing

to be notified and to attend sentence review hearings and sentence reduction hearings

to be notified of any change of status such as prison release, permanent interstate transfer, or escape, and the date of the parole board hearing, when requested by the victim through the victim advocate

to address or submit a written statement for consideration by the parole board on the defendant's release and to be notified of the decision of the board, when requested by the victim through the victim advocate

Notification of Inmate Custody Changes

New Hampshire law provides crime victims with the right to be notified of changes in inmate custody status. Upon request, timely notification is provided to victims and survivors for inmate custody changes involving facility transfers, reduced custody, releases, parole revocations, escape and death of inmate.

Advocacy and Support During Reduced Custody Decisions

Some victims and survivors feel anxious and concerned about their safety when inmates are considered for reduced custody or release. With respect for this concern, the Victim Services Coordinator collaborates with prison classification and community corrections staff.

Accompaniment at Parole Hearings

Victims have a legal right to provide input to the NH Adult Parole Board prior to its decision about an inmate's release. They may choose to attend hearings with or without the inmate present, or may send written input to the Board. Victim Services staff are available to accompany and support victims and survivors who choose to attend Parole Board hearings.

Reasonable Protection from Intimidation and Harassment

Crime victims have a right to be free from intimidation by the offender. The NHDOC offers reasonable measures for supporting the emotional and physical safety of victims.

Information, Referral and Support

Support and information is available for victims and survivors interested in learning more about an inmates term in prison. Helpful publications are available and include: "Victim Notice - Keeping Victims Informed and Involved"; "Probation and Parole - Community Safety, Victim Respect, Offender Accountability"; and "Time in Prison - Community Safety, Opportunity for Change".

Prison Tours

For some crime victims and survivors, seeing firsthand where inmates are incarcerated helps to understand what "time in prison" is really like. Consistent with security needs, the NHDOC will arrange tours of our correctional facilities upon request.

Restitution

When an offender is ordered to reimburse the victim for economic losses resulting from the crime, the Division of Field Services collects restitution and disburses money to the victim. By law, the NHDOC and courts have authority to enforce each restitution order until it is paid in full.

Victim Offender Dialogue (by victim request)

The NHDOC recognizes the many impacts of violent crime upon victims and survivors. Victim-Offender Dialogue can empower victims and survivors to meet with the offender and address the personal impacts of crime. The Victim Services office can coordinate a structured, facilitated dialogue in a safe environment.

Impact

In partnership with victim advocates and NHDOC education staff, a victim impact educational program is available to many prison inmates. IMPACT teaches them how crime harms people and communities - physically, emotionally, and financially. It is an opportunity for inmates to improve empathy toward victims and other people. It offers opportunities for interested victims and survivors to be involved in correctional efforts to prevent further victimization in the community. IMPACT classes address the multiple effects of crime, including property/robbery, assault, homicide, domestic violence, sexual assault, hate crime, driving while intoxicated/drug offenses, child abuse and crimes against the elderly.

New Hampshire Mediation Program

An alternative informal way to resolve a complaint of discrimination based on age, race, sex, disability, national origin, religion, or marital and familial status. The New Hampshire Commission for Human Rights (NHCHR) provides a voluntary mediation program to assist parties in reaching a satisfactory mutual resolution to a complaint. It is an informal way of settling disputes without going to court. In mediation, both parties sit down face-to-face with a trained mediator. No judge is present. The mediator helps you arrive at a solution.

As a victim or survivor of a violent crime in New Hampshire, you may apply for compensation from the New Hampshire Victims' Assistance Commission. You can request up to \$10,000 in compensation for hospital/medical expenses, funeral expenses, loss of wages, or other out of pocket expenses. You may also be eligible for as much as to \$2,000 in mental health therapy costs. In order to qualify there must be no other form of third party payment (e.g., life insurance or medical insurance). Property losses are not covered.
