Note: A bond or other financial guarantee, unless waived by the Board of Selectmen, will be required to be posted by all Utility companies (ie electric, telephone, cable) in an amount to be determined by the Board of Selectmen to insure that all work shall be completed in thirty (30) days and in conformance with Town requirements.

Said bond may be used by the Town to repair any damage or hazard condition that was caused by any work done in the Town right-of-way by Utilities who have not, or will not, return the highway to its original condition within thirty (30) days.

The authority having jurisdiction shall notify the Utility that the bond will be taken to do the necessary repairs in five (5) days, at which time the Town or its agent will do the necessary repairs. Upon completion of the repairs, the Town shall notify the Utility of the amount expended. The Utility shall then, at once, reinstate the bond to its original value.

Exception: In the event of a hazardous condition, the Town or its agent may take the bond to make necessary repairs to correct the hazard condition.
